
Visting Wright's Home and Studio


I am going to visit

It is where the architect Frank Lloyd Wright lived.




I will know I am there when I see the wall made of bricks and shingles.

There will be someone to tell me more information about each room.




If I need help, I will ask someone who is wearing a lanyard with a red nametag.




They can answer my questions and help me if I need something during my tour.
